

Modern Foreign Language (MFL) Access Arrangements - Information regarding the application of access arrangements to the various MFL components

Due to the varied nature of assessment for language exams, there are some instances where certain access arrangements are either not allowed or not appropriate to the method of assessment.

The table below sets out the most common access arrangements that students may have been awarded and the default position for how these will be applied to the different MFL components/qualifications.
