



COVID-19 HOME TESTING – How to report your child's LFT test

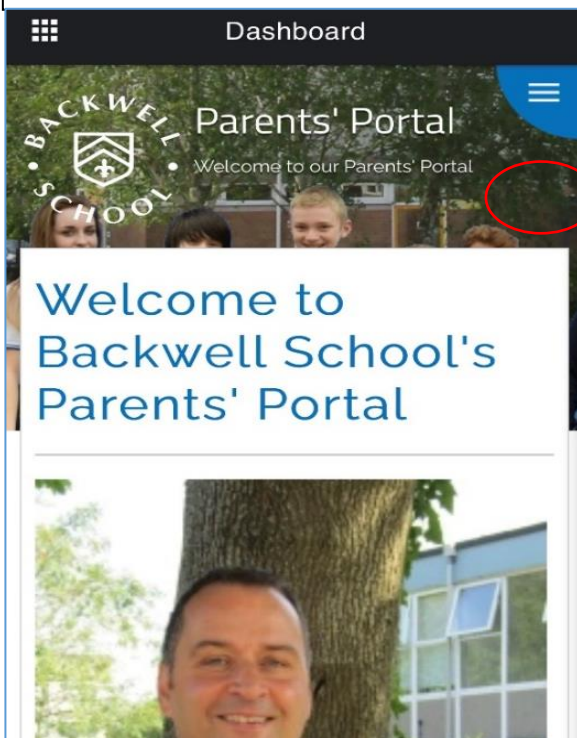
Students are asked to undertake a lateral flow test (LFT) twice a week, on a Sunday and Wednesday evening, to pick up asymptomatic cases in the school community.

Test kits are distributed via the school free of charge. Full instructions on undertaking the test are provided with the test kit box. Please follow the instructions below to report your child's test.

1. Log onto the [Parents' Portal](#) using your username and password.

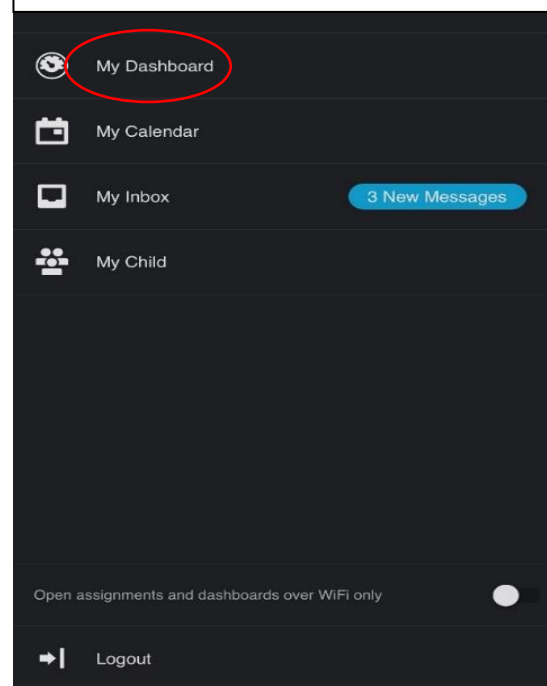

3. Click on the blue area with three lines (top right of Dashboard)

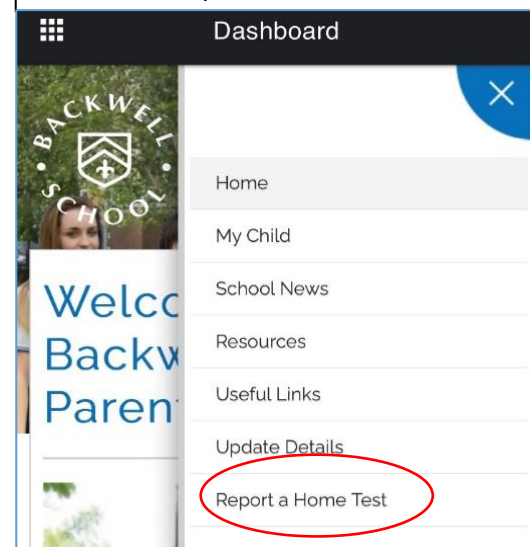


Please note. The above screenshots are via the frog app. If accessing via your internet browser then simply select 'Report a Home Test' from the top menu bar.

2. Select 'My Dashboard'.



4. Select 'Report a Home Test'



5. Enter the details of the test.

- Enter student surname in first field – a list will appear if you have more than one child at Backwell. Select name of first child that has been tested.
- Enter the date.
- Enter Test Strip ID or QR code on the test strip.
- Select from three options for results.
- Press green button to submit.

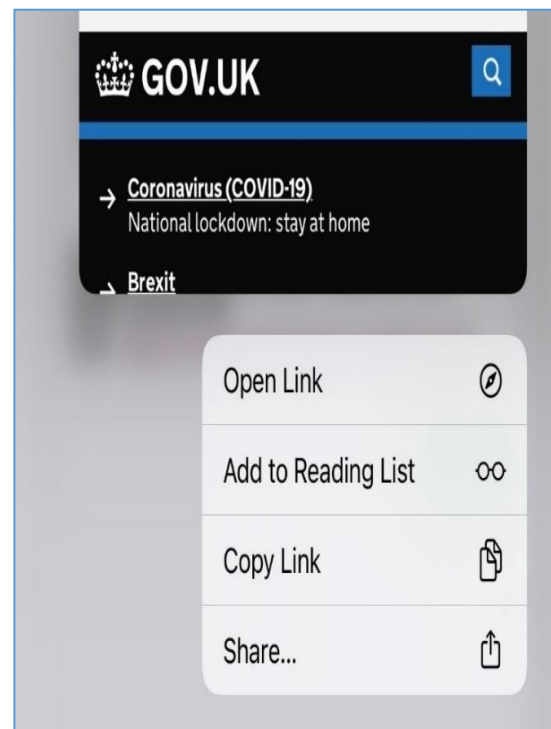
6. Report the result to the NHS
