

## MORE VACCINATION CLINICS ARE AVAILABLE AT BROCKWAY MEDICAL CENTRE, NAILSEA ON SATURDAY 15TH JANUARY

Our next vaccination clinic for ANY eligible 12 - 17 year olds AND adults has now been set up for Saturday 15th January. This is for 1st, 2nd and 3rd doses. Anyone who books but is not eligible for a vaccination will have to be turned away on the day.

If in doubt call our booking line 01275 866761 between 9am and 4pm weekdays for them to book you in.

For 12 - 17 year olds the eligibility criteria is a little different and guidance is outlined below. Anyone who books a vaccination and is not eligible will unfortunately have to be turned away on the day.

It is important that 12 -17yrs olds read the below carefully to the end first before reacting.

The criteria for us being able to vaccinate 12 to 17 yr olds is as follows: You must not have had a positive Covid PCR result within 12 weeks of the 15th January. (This is different to adults where the rule is 28 days) You must be:

- Aged 12 17 (not yet attained 18 years) on 8th January 2022
  Plus one of the following criteria also applies:
- This will be your 1st dose
- If it's your 2nd dose 12 weeks has elapsed by 8th January since your 1st dose
- If you are clinically vulnerable or live in a household with someone who is severely immunosuppressed the gap before the 2nd dose can be administered reduces to 8 weeks after the first dose

The 1st and 2nd doses are termed the primary course of vaccination. Some patients aged 12 -17yrs will already be eligible to receive a 3rd dose by 8th January, this is called either the booster or 3rd dose depending on your personal clinical situation.

To fulfil that eligibility 12 weeks must have elapsed since completing your primary course and one of the following criteria must apply to you:

- You are aged 16 or 17 years on 15th January
- You are aged 12 15 years and are clinically vulnerable
- You are aged 12 15 years and live in the same household as someone who is severely immunosuppressed.

Only book if you fulfil the above criteria and are able to take an appointment offered to you for Saturday 15th January.

Please do not call with enquiries about other available dates. At this moment in time there are no other options available.
