Carbon Busting Challenge 2

Over the next two weeks we are inviting the whole school community to take part in our second Carbon Busting Challenge. This is following our Meat-free Monday (Challenge 1) aimed at achieving the United Nations Climate Change Bronze Award that the school is working towards this year. Our second challenge is to buy local produce and reduce the air miles of our food.

Did you know that a plane emits approximately 4056 lbs of carbon per ton moved 1000 miles, a boat is much lower at 97lbs of carbon per ton moved 1000 miles, however sourcing locally, or at least from the UK can vastly reduce that carbon dioxide emission. Buying local produce could reduce our overall carbon footprint by 4-5%. If eating local ingredients isn't always possible, you can still check to see where the product has come from and consider whether it's been shipped by sea or air! Plus, by making a conscious effort to eat food that's grown close to you, you'll be doing your bit for the local economy too.

Students are being encouraged to talk about foods that can be sourced locally and the benefit this has for our carbon footprints. We hope you will join us in this challenge and if your child lets their tutor know that they have bought food that is locally sourced, it will contribute towards their Environmental Award.
