#### Start of the new School Year

### **School Uniform**

A reminder that we expect all students to be in full, correct, uniform. <u>Full details of our uniform</u> <u>expectations can be found on our website</u>. Pupils not wearing correct uniform will be challenged and staff will contact home to discuss what items of their uniform needs changing to ensure that our expectations are met.

As you prepare and purchase school uniform and equipment over the next few weeks, please ensure that the items you buy are suitable. Trousers are a particular issue; they should be black and must not be jeans/denim, too tight fitting or leggings. If you are planning on ordering new uniform for September, then you will need to place your **order before Tuesday 1 August** to ensure delivery before the start of term. Can we also take this opportunity to urge parents to label all school clothes and bags? All named equipment that goes to lost property is returned, however we regularly end a term with hundreds of un-named and un-claimed items. Remember those little name tags you had sewn into your school uniform when you were at school? They are still very valuable!

## **Equipment**

### **Catering Tills**

We will be updating our catering tills over the summer. This means that we will need to register all staff and students again for biometric, thumbprint recognition. As before, all data will remain within the school in the form of an algorithm which cannot be used to recreate the thumbprint. We will use the consent preferences you have already provided for this so there is no need to provide additional consent however please get in contact if you would like to discuss or amend this. All staff and students will also be provided with a numeric PIN which can be used instead of the thumbprint.

## Lockers

We will be changing the way lockers are provided on the school site from September. We are moving to an external provider who will manage the entire system on our behalf. If your child has a locker currently then this will need to be returned in September and any remaining deposit will be returned

to you (or you may wish to donate the money to the school fund if you prefer). We will provide further information about how to acquire a new locker at the start of the new term.
