## **Transport**

As I said in last week's email, there are planned works on the rail network next week. North Somerset Council have today told us that they have put in place alternative transport for those Backwell students whose home-to-school transport is via train. They are contacting families directly with that information.

Other students who use the train, sixth formers or pupils travelling from stations in Weston-Super-Mare, should use the rail replacement service or seek alternative transport provision for the whole of next week.

#### **Nasal Flu Immunisations**

We have been advised that nurses from Sirona Care and Health (part of the School Immunisation Team) will be in school, during school hours, on Tuesday 7 and Wednesday 8 November 2023 to offer flu vaccinations to all children in Years 7, 8, 9, 10 and 11.

They are being offered the vaccination this winter to help protect them from flu and serious complications such as bronchitis and pneumonia. Vaccinating your child will also help protect you, your family and friends. The flu vaccine is administered using a nasal spray, this vaccine is free and painless, please ensure you complete your consent form at
