Dear Parents/Carers

Over the next few weeks, we will be using assemblies to talk to students about Palestine and Israel. We have considered carefully how to approach this subject. We want Backwell pupils to be interested in the world around them, to be empathetic to the suffering of others and inquisitive into the causes of significant world events. But we want to do this is in a clearly politically neutral way and in a way which discourages generalisation, over-simplification and prejudice. Bearing this in mind, we are using materials from an organisation called 'Solutions not Sides' which aims to tackle Antisemitism, Islamophobia and polarisation around the issue of the Israeli-Palestinian conflict. You can read more about the organisation here https://solutionsnotsides.co.uk/. We hope that their materials will leave Backwell pupils better informed about the complex history of Israel and Palestine and help them navigate for themselves the challenging issues raised by the current crisis there.

I want to congratulate Year 11 pupils on completing Trial Exam week. I am sure that it has been a valuable – and tiring week. The vast majority of students approached the exams with maturity, impressing our Exams Team with their excellent behaviour. We are continuing our push to practise for all aspects of the summer examination season by having a trial 'Results Day' on Friday 8 December. Pupils will receive their full set of results that morning with their Tutor and Head of House on hand for support and celebration!

A reminder that next Wednesday (November 22) is an INSET Day. Teaching staff at Backwell are traveling to Gordano School to meet with colleagues from other LSP Schools for a day of training which includes a significant focus on 'Universal Provision': how classroom teachers ensure they meet the needs of all pupils, including those with special educational needs.

North Somerset Consultation

North Somerset Council are holding a drop-in community event where residents, businesses and local groups are welcome to put forward their views and comments on a number of suggested design improvements for the Backwell area.

Improvements are planned as part of the 'Bus Service Improvement Plan' scheme. North Somerset Council received £48m from the Department for Transport to help make bus travel easier, faster and better coordinated across the North Somerset area. This will help communities, the environment as well as the local economy.

During the drop-in event, visitors will be able to view 'Concept Proposals' which include designs for improved bus stops, bus priority measures as well as a new transport hub. Plans in Backwell will not solely be based on increasing bus usage, but also on how pedestrians, mobility users, cyclists and motorists can better use the area in future too.
