Dear Parent/Carer

Year 10 GCSE Geography Fieldwork to the Quantocks

As part of your child's GCSE geography course, they are expected to complete two days' worth of fieldtrips. The first of these days will be in the first couple of weeks back after the Easter holidays to visit the River Holford in the Quantocks, to investigate the changes in the long profile of a river and practice collecting fieldwork data. The information obtained will provide the material needed for lessons following and paper three of the GCSE.

As we have a large GCSE cohort, the trip will be running on three different days. Pupils have been allocated a day with the rest of their class (see below). Please note, due to insurance purposes, and to ensure we keep within the student/staff ratio, **if a pupil cannot make the day they have been scheduled for, we will be unable to move them to a different day in the week.**

We will travel to the Quantocks by coach, **leaving school during registration and returning to school by 3.10 pm** so students will be able to get home their usual way and attend after school clubs.

On the day of their trip, students should come to school dressed appropriately for a day in the hills. **They will need waterproof and windproof outerwear and stout shoes for walking. In addition to normal writing materials and a camera, your child will need a clipboard on which to rest their worksheets. As we will be out of school all day, we ask that you provide your child with a snack, packed lunch and drink.** For insurance reasons, it will not be possible to release students other than from school on their return.

Parents/Carers are asked to make a contribution of £9.00 towards the cost of the trip. Please make payments **by Thursday 28 March 2024** via www.parentpay.com, the school's online cashless payment system, **which will also act as permission.**
