Over the next few weeks, the school will share with parents how we are supporting the government's initiative to improve school attendance to ensure that all students benefit fully from being in school. So, over the coming weeks, if you follow us on our social media platforms, X or Facebook, you will see a number of posts about attendance with the hashtag #AttendanceCounts, which will make a good discussion point if you are struggling to get your child into school. From the first day of term to the last, the small moments in a school day make a real difference to your child. Only one third of pupils who attend school less than 90% of the time achieve 9-4 grades in English and maths. 84% of regular attenders achieve this. #AttendanceCounts.
