IMPORTANT EXAM INFORMATION – Summer 2024 entries

To help students and parents/carers manage exam entries and exam timetables throughout the year, we are migrating to a new online system called 'SchoolWorkSpace'. This keeps all exam information visible in one place via a Parent/Carer and Student Exam Portal.

We will no longer be issuing paper copies of exam entries or exam timetables.

Students who have entries for Summer 2024 exam season should have received an email earlier this week asking them to sign in to this new system to check and confirm their details and entries. Parents/carers were also sent an email inviting them to check and confirm their child's entries. The email contains links on how to access the user guide for the new Exam Portal.

It is important that this is completed by Monday 5 February 2024.

Any changes to entries notified after Monday 5 February 2024 may incur fees.

A key exam information booklet will be issued next week to all students taking exams. Students should be bringing them home to share with you. Look out for it – it's bright orange!
