#### **Entry to Backwell Sixth Form Interviews**

The Sixth Form Team and Mr Nunes will be interviewing students that have applied to Backwell Sixth Form next Tuesday 6 and Wednesday 7 February. Students should have been informed of their individual meeting time and location by their tutor and it has also been set as an assignment on FROG. Please remind your child to check that they know when their interview is, to bring their latest report if possible and to be prepared to discuss their subject choices - they do not need to be worried about the interview. Offer letters will be sent to students early next term.

#### Non-school uniform day

Next Friday 9 February, is a non-school uniform day in aid of Childrens' Hospice South West and students will be able to wear their own clothes in exchange for a donation towards this charity. As we have done previously with Children in Need, we are now offering the option of donating online via the following ParentPay Shop webpage, where you will find the donations item lower down the page:

The minimum donation for our non-uniform charity days is now £2. We have made that change partly because ParentPay Shop charge an administration fee for using the service and partly because the suggested donation of £1 had remained unchanged for many years. This remains a voluntary contribution and one advantage of the online system is that whether and how much families contribute is not public to pupils.

We would encourage parents to donate online, however if you still prefer to make a cash donation, your child can hand it in to Reception on the day.

#### **Environment Committee Clothes Swap Event**

Did you know that 92 million tonnes of textiles waste are produced every year. So that's why the Environment Committee at school are hosting a second-hand clothes swap at Backwell. The clothes swap will be taking place on Wednesday 28 February in the main theatre at lunch time. Students can dop off any spare or unwanted clothes and exchange them for other items that have been donated.

The drop off point will be in Reception and open from the 5 - 25 February. All clothes must be dropped off before tutor time. Clothes need to be brought in in a plastic bag with the student's name, tutor group and the number of items on a piece of paper inside the bag. A maximum number of 10 items of clothing per person can be donated. All clothes need to be washed and of a good quality. Please no swimwear, underwear or socks, as we are not able to accept these.

The number of items donated equals the maximum number of items the student will be able to take out of the clothes swap. Clothes can also be purchased for 50p per item with all profits being donated to the Wildlife Trust for adopting a hedgehog.

#### National Measles Alert ...

The UK Health Security Agency has reported an increase in measles across the country. There are no recent cases reported in North Somerset, but it's important to make sure you and your family are protected in case it spreads here. Measles can have serious and sometimes fatal consequences, so please make sure your child is up to date with MMR vaccinations. Check

your child's Red Book or with your GP surgery if you're unsure. For more information about measles visit <u>https://www.nhs.uk/measles/</u>.

Measles is an infection that spreads very easily and can cause serious problems in some people. You are very unlikely to get measles if you've had both doses of the MMR vaccine or you've had measles before. Measles symptoms to be aware of include:

- high fever
- sore, red, watery eyes
- coughing
- aching and feeling generally unwell
- a blotchy red brown rash, which usually appears after the initial symptoms.

Anyone who thinks they have measles are being advised to stay at home and phone their GP or NHS 111 for advice.
