Dear Parents/Carers

In the week of the latest Budget, I thought it would be an appropriate time to update parents and carers on the financial situation for the education sector and Backwell in particular.

As with most schools, Backwell is facing considerable financial challenge at the moment. Costs for schools are extremely high. One major reason for this is that the recent pay rises for teachers and support staff, despite being well-deserved and arguably insufficient, have not been fully matched by increased funding for schools. This is particularly the case for schools like Backwell who are amongst the lower-funded in the country and, therefore, have been most affected by the government decision not to increase what are called 'minimum perpupil funding levels.' As a consequence of our income failing to keep up with our costs, we have been working very hard in financial planning for next year to make the cost-saving changes necessary while reducing as much as possible any undesirable impact on the education provision for the pupils at Backwell. I hope and expect that we will be successful in that aim and that, therefore, parents and carers will not perceive any reduction in the levels of expertise, care and support offered to their children. However, the budget announcement of just a 1% rise (above inflation) in day-to-day public sector spending indicates an ongoing squeeze on funding for schools. Meanwhile the main teaching unions continue to make the case for significant pay rises for 2024-25 and beyond.

Thank you to all parents and carers for your understanding and support as the school and the Trust continue to work hard to retain the best possible educational opportunities for Backwell pupils against the backdrop of economic challenge and unrest.

To help students and parents/carers manage exam entries and exam timetables (real and trials) throughout the year, we are migrating to a new online system supported by **'SchoolWorkSpace'**.

We will no longer issue paper copies of exam timetables.

Instead, students and their parents/carers will be sent an email with a link to view the student's exam timetable. As this is a 'dynamic link' it will always display the latest timetable information and reflect any late room/seat changes. The emails were sent this week from **noreply@SchoolWorkSpace**.

Students must view their timetable and check they know their exam dates/times and room. When the link is open there is an option to print the timetable (the school library printer is available if needed). Alternatively, you can take a screenshot of the timetable on a device for future reference.
