Aspens Caterers Price Increase

Aspens, our catering provider, are committed to providing nutritious menus, catering for a wide range of dietary preferences while also ensuring good value for money and using locally sourced produce. However, after two years of frozen prices they have taken the difficult decision to increase the cost of our school meals. From 1 April 2024, the cost of a school meal deal will increase to £2.65 (currently £2.45). All other prices will increase by 8% and a complete list can be found here. These new prices reflect necessary adjustments to cover continued high food inflation and increasing operating costs.

The school's till system defaults to a daily spend cap of £5. Please be reminded that this cap can be adjusted upwards or downwards on request from a parent/carer. Please email the school if you would like this amended for your child. Free school meal and pupil premium allowances will be adjusted in the system to reflect the price increases.

We want to reassure you that this decision was made after careful consideration, and we understand the financial concerns this may raise for some families. If your circumstances have changed, you may be entitled to free school meals. To find out more please visit <u>https://www.gov.uk/apply-free-school-meals</u>. Please be assured that your application will be treated with the utmost confidentiality, and it will not affect any other benefits you may be receiving.
