Dear Parents/Carers

Many of you will have been shocked this week by news reports from a school in South Wales where a student and two members of staff were attacked by a student. Thankfully, such incidents are extremely rare in this country. Nevertheless, I thought it would be appropriate to share with parents and carers how we prepare for such an event. We have a 'Critical Incident Policy' which details how we would respond to a range of unlikely, but possible, threats. This policy has been reviewed and staff trained in our last INSET Day at the end of March. We will be spending time in tutor sessions over the next two weeks in explaining our approach with pupils, including demonstrating the sounds that would be played on our 'tannoy' system.

Congratulations to our Year 12 students at the end of their Trial Exam Week and the very best of luck to students in Years 11 and 13, some of whom begin elements of their actual examinations next week. Year 13 students studying Art, Photography or Textiles have their examination time while all students in Year 11 and 13 taking Modern Foreign Languages undergo their speaking exams. - Link materials chemistry to real life applications and current research at the University.
- Show students how information they learn at GCSE links to topics in higher level. qualifications/ongoing research.

You will have access to your phone or a laptop to make use of tools such as Mentimeter, allowing you to ask anonymous questions to the presenters and Student Ambassadors. There are likely to be a few schools per session.
