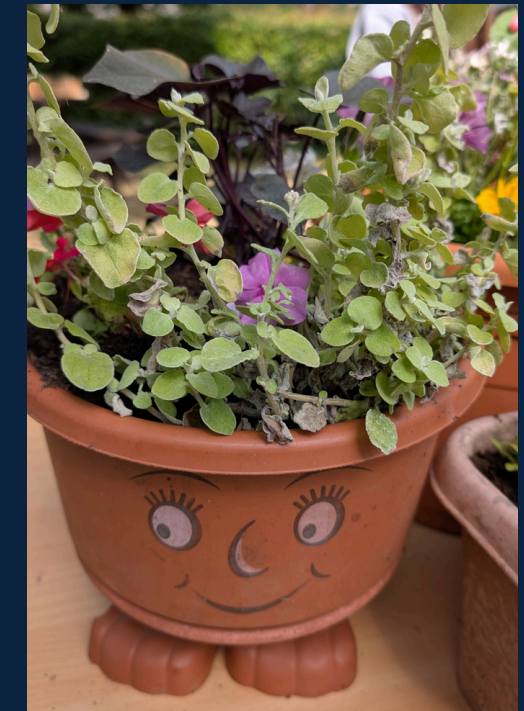
Staff-led activities
