Year 7 Enrichment Week 2026 - Monday 22 June to Friday 26 June

During the Summer Term, the normal school timetable is suspended for a week while students take part in trips and activities tailored to their year group. Enrichment Week is an important aspect of Backwell School life, giving students the opportunity to enjoy new experiences, learn different skills and build strong bonds with their peers. Trips take students out of their comfort zone and provide a great opportunity to enhance their learning out of the classroom, try something new and create lifelong memories.

The Year 7s will be split into five groups who will rotate through a series of tailor-made day trips and onsite activities. The students will enjoy a very varied week that will see them walking in the footsteps of Harry Potter, meeting fascinating exotic animals, getting active in the Mendips and bonding with their peers during onsite activities. The cost of the Year 7 Enrichment Week is £205 per student. As Enrichment Week involves the school working with external providers; please help us to meet the deposit deadlines by following the payment schedule. YEAR 7 ENRICHMENT WEEK 2026 TERMS AND CONDITIONS

The cost of the Enrichment Week activities is £205

Please see table below for the minimum expected payment schedule. **All deposits are non-refundable** and are required in conjunction with the Student Essential Information and Behaviour Agreement requested via MS Form links on the School Comms letter home. The deposit amount for £69 is now available on ParentPay for payment.

If you are having problems paying the instalments, please notify the school in writing at the earliest opportunity. These monthly amounts have been set to ensure that the balance is paid by 30 April 2026; however, you can pay the balance in full at any time before this date. We expect the trip to be paid in full by 30 April 2026 to ensure we can fulfil our contractual obligations to the activity providers.

Medical and Emergency Contact Information

Your child will not be allowed to participate in any out of school activity without providing the Student Essential Information which will be requested via a MS Forms link on the School Comms letter home. It is your responsibility to inform us of any changes to the information on this form prior to the departure date. This information is used in case of emergency as parental consent for treatment by the trip leader.

Insurance

All trips are fully insured by the school's insurance provider. If your child is unable to take up their place due to a medical condition during Enrichment Week, we require confirmation in writing from a doctor. Please contact us as soon as possible.

Electronic items such as cameras, mobile phones and games consoles are not covered by the school insurance. These are taken at the owner's risk.

Behaviour

The school reserves the right to exclude from any trip/activity a student whose behaviour has given cause for concern at any stage before the trip. Students removed from a trip for a behaviour issue (including attendance) will not be entitled to a full refund. If a student does not behave to a reasonable standard whilst on the trip, arrangements will be made for them to return before the rest of the group. The parent/carer will be responsible for any expenses incurred as a result of this. The cost for any property damaged due to the carelessness / misconduct of a student will be the responsibility of the parent/carer.
