Dear Parents and Carers,

RE: Measles, Chickenpox and Shingles.

Please may we ask for your co-operation in an important matter?

We would like to make you aware that one of our pupils is currently receiving medical treatment at Bristol Children's Hospital. As a result, they are particularly vulnerable to infections such as measles, mumps, slapped cheek, chickenpox and shingles.

We kindly ask for your support in helping us protect this child's health. If your child is suspected of having measles or chickenpox, please inform the school immediately.

In the case of chickenpox, the pupil who is vulnerable would need a medical review within three days of any contact, so early notification is extremely important.

We would also like to take this opportunity to remind families that if your child has diarrhoea and vomiting, they must remain at home and only return to school after 48 hours have passed since their last symptoms.

Please be reassured that your child is not at risk as a result of this situation. However, the wellbeing of the pupil receiving treatment does rely on the cooperation and consideration of our school community, and we greatly appreciate your support.
