Dear Parents / Carers

Year 12 Parents' and Carers' Evening: Thursday 18 June 2026

On **Thursday 18 June** we will be holding a Parents' and Carers' Evening for students in Year 12.

This is an opportunity for you to have a short meeting with your child's subject teachers to discuss how they are progressing with their studies. All our parents' and carers' evenings are held via video call, with appointments booked in advance.

The online booking system will open one week before the meeting date, at **6.00 pm on Thursday 11 June** and close at **4.00 pm on Wednesday 17 June**.

Once the booking system opens you can log in here <https://backwell.schoolcloud.co.uk/> and choose your appointment times with teachers. Once finished, you will receive an email confirmation of your bookings. **If you are unable to arrange an appointment with your child's teacher, please contact them by email and they will provide an update on your child's progress.**

Teachers will be available between 4.00 pm and 6.45 pm (unless stated otherwise in the booking system) and each appointment will last 7 minutes.

One key thing to be aware of is that it is **essential to be on time** for your appointment. The appointment will start at the time booked. If you are late, or leave and re-join the call, **it does not reset the timer**. The appointment will always end at the scheduled time. The teacher is not able to override the system.

To attend our virtual parents' evening, you will need to have as a minimum:

- A device with a microphone and speaker/headphones
- A compatible up-to-date web browser:
 - ✓ iPhone/iPad: Safari, Chrome
 - ✓ Android: Chrome, Firefox or the Samsung browser.
 - ✓ Windows: Chrome, Firefox or Microsoft Edge (Chromium)
 - ✓ Mac: Safari, Chrome or Firefox
 - ✓ Linux: Chrome or Firefox
