Year 11 GCSE Exam Information

Year 11 have made a great start to the summer exam season. Their hard work in revision lessons and their conduct in the exams has been excellent. They should be very proud of their efforts so far.

After half term, year 11 students are on study leave and only need to attend school when they have an exam or if they are attending a booster revision session.

School uniform must be worn at all times when students are on the school site for exams and/or revision booster sessions. Students who are not in the correct school uniform will have to get changed into the correct uniform to sit an exam, in line with exam regulations.

All students can access their exam timetable on the exams portal, so they know when and where their exams are.

The Year 11 revision programme continues throughout study leave. Students can continue to use their personalised revision programme and access the wealth of resources available for every exam subject.

If students would like to study in school during study leave, **they must sign in at reception** and work in the library. Students must be in the correct uniform and follow normal school expectations regarding behaviour and conduct on site.

Revision booster sessions

We are running revision booster sessions to support students with their revision during study leave. These are optional sessions and will run throughout the remaining weeks of the exam season. These sessions have been well attended in previous years and students have found them invaluable in supporting their revision during study leave.

Students attending a booster session must **sign in at reception** (even if they have an exam that day) When students sign in, they will be told which room to go to for each session.

Revision boosters start at **12 noon** and will run for approx. 40 minutes.
