Instrumental Lessons Autumn 2020

Please find below the information for applying for and taking instrumental lessons at the school.

Information

The Music Department at Backwell School offers lessons on the following instruments: strings, brass, woodwind, drum kit and orchestral percussion, guitar (classical, acoustic, electric) and bass guitar, voice, and piano. Most of our teachers are North Somerset peripatetic teachers and we currently have four private teachers. The charges and organisation of lessons with private teachers is the same but communications are direct with the teacher rather than through Backwell School.

- **North Somerset Peripatetic Music Lessons:** Students receive 30 lessons per annum, either individually (25 minutes at £18.50 per lesson), in pairs (30 minutes at £11.00 per lesson) or in groups of three (30 minutes at £7.50 per lesson), depending on their level of study.

Please note that the number of lessons received each two terms varies per year. For example, this current academic year, students will receive 12 lessons in Terms 1 and 2, 9 lessons in Terms 3 and 4, and 9 lessons in Terms 5 and 6. It is recommended that students working at grades 1 and 2 level have lessons in pairs or groups of three, those at grades 3 and 4 level have them in pairs and those at grade 5 level and above have individual lessons.

- **Private Music Lessons:** Students receive about 10 individual half-hour lessons per two terms at a cost of around £18.50 per lesson. Currently, lessons for **classical guitar, electric guitar, double bass and singing** are provided by a variety of experienced practitioners. Please indicate on the attached application form if you wish to request lessons from one of our 'private' teachers. Your details will be passed on to the relevant teacher and you will be contacted and payment arranged with them.

If you would like to apply for partial financial assistance towards your son/daughter's music lessons, and your son/daughter is in receipt of free school meals and you would like us to pay the contribution from your personal allocation of Pupil Premium funding, please contact the Finance Team on 01275 465941. or via email to finance@backwellschool.net. (Parents/Carers of students who are entitled to free school meals or are in receipt of Child Tax Credits maybe eligible for this financial assistance.) Alternatively, information and application forms are available to download from the Backwell School website

If your son/daughter would like to take instrumental lessons please fill in the attached form and return it to vcooper@backwellschool.net. We generally start new pupils in January, April and September.

Lessons take place during the school day. Timetables are constructed so that the same academic lesson is not missed regularly. If possible, students in Years 10 and 11 will be timetabled over break, lunch or tutor times, and Sixth Form students during their free periods. Pupils receiving instrumental or singing lessons are expected to support the extra-curricular work of the Music Department.
