Dear Parents/Carers

Following the Government's announcements earlier this week, and confirmation that North Somerset will be in Tier 3 from Wednesday 2 December, I want to update parents on what this means for us here at Backwell School.

The Government has clearly stated that all schools are to remain open in whichever tier their local community is placed in and the updated Department for Education guidance on operating a school in the new system of tiers from Wednesday 2 December does not require any changes to the procedures and processes we already have in place here at Backwell School. However [Tier 3](#) does contain strict restrictions on socialising. Please do all you can to ensure that your children are not gathering in large groups in outdoor areas and please note that visiting/socialising indoors is banned. Any breaches of these expectations has a potentially significant impact on us all.

I appreciate that many parents are anxious about COVID-19 and the impact it is having on their children, be this the potential health implications or the mental health impact of social restrictions. My staff are all working incredibly hard to ensure that as a school we are complying to all expectations set out by the Government (these can be read [here](#)) as well as provide a positive educational environment for those in school and remote learning for those in isolation. I politely request that you read the government guidelines, and the [dedicated school information on COVID-19](#) before contacting us about any concerns you may have.

We must follow the information given to us by central government, the Department for Education and Public Health England and ensure we are complying with our risk assessment. Our risk assessment is regularly updated and is checked and signed off by our Governors and the Board of Trustees at the Lighthouse Schools Partnership.

We are doing our very best to keep parents and students informed and updated – all letters, and the Friday email home, are saved on our website for you to refer back to.

The ongoing pandemic is challenging time for everyone and I am very proud of how school staff continue to adapt under the immense pressures they are currently facing.

## Cooler weather and school uniform

Whilst the forecast for the next week is dry, it is predicted to be cooler than previous weeks. A reminder to all that due to COVID-19 we are required to ventilate all classrooms by opening windows and doors, so students may like to do the following to keep warm:

Students are welcome to wear extra layers to school; for example a plain white/nude T-shirt or vest under their polo shirt.
